Resolved - 1st - That notice shall be given in a public newspaper of the District, at least three months previous to the meeting of Council - setting forth that application will be made for the confirmation of a certain Road - and specifying the lots and conceptions of the Township thus which such road is desired -

2nd That as often as it shall appear necessary to alter any existing, or open any new Road, the Road Surveyor on application in writing signed by twelve Freeholders, setting forth the intended alteration, or new Road, shall proceed to examine the grounds, and report thereon, which Report, accompanied by a Diagram shall be transmitted to the Clerk of the District Council on or before the third day of the Session.

3rd That any person or persons, desirous of opposing any such Road, or claiming compensation for the opening thereof, shall address the Council by Petition, stating the reasons for such opposition, or the grounds of his or their claim; and shall cause the same to be presented to the Council on, at farthest, the third day of its sitting.

4th That the Party or Parties, or their Council and Attorneys, shall be heard by a Committee of the Council appointed for that purpose - during that Session of the Council.

5th That the expenses of the Survey, and the attendance of the Surveyor to give evidence, when necessary, shall be defrayed by the Petitioners - unless the Council order otherwise.

6th That where any Road that has been surveyed and laid out according to Law, previous to the passing of the Act 4th & 5th Vict. Chap. 10, and which has not been already opened, or where any Road, which by the alteration of lines, it shall be deemed necessary or equitable to alter, or place where formerly reported, it shall not be necessary for the Road Surveyor to examine and report the same, as it is hereby foreseen forth, with respect to the opening of a new Road; save and except that it shall be necessary

responsible for having freeholders to make application by Petition to the District Council for the opening of such Road in its proper place.
