

Minutes of the June Session of the Council
of the Corporation of the County of Simcoe
Council Chambers Barrie
June 16th 1884

The Council met today pursuant to adjournment from the January session. The Warden in the chair Present all members except Dr. Apton, Mess. Mead and Horrell.

Be it therefore Resolved - That whereas aid was granted by the County and various minor Municipalities of the County of Simcoe to the extent of \$200,000 by means of which grant the Construction of the following Railway was secured, and without which they could not have been built: - Hamilton & North Western Extension of the North from Barrie to Gravenhurst, the Midland from Oulick Town to Midland City, the North Simcoe from Colwell to Penetanguishene, That such aid was only granted to the above Railway on the good faith and understanding that they would continue independent lines of Railway, and that the assumption thereof by the Federal Parliament gives the County of Simcoe and minor Municipalities within the same a just claim to have the money so granted refunded by the Dominion, and that the above extensions be referred to the Standing Committee on Finance.
