

BY-LAW NO. 4660

OF

THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF SIMCOE

A by-law to amend the County's Sign By-law No. 4630.

WHEREAS, Under the Authority of the Public Transportation and Highway Improvement Act, R.S.O. 1990, C.P. 50, Section 63, a County may, with respect to the roads under its jurisdiction and control, by by-law prohibit or regulate the display of any sign, notice or advertising device within 400 metres of any limit of any road;

WHEREAS the Council of the County of Simcoe enacted By-law Number 4330 to prohibit or regulate the display of any sign, notice or advertising device within a controlled area of a County road;

AND WHEREAS by the adoption of Report No. 01-007 of the Transportation Services Committee, County Council deems it necessary and expedient to amend the wording of Section 2.1 of the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Simcoe enacts as follows:

1. That Section 2.1 be deleted and replaced with the following:

No Person shall erect, display, repair or alter, or cause or permit to be erected, displayed, repaired or altered a sign, including a temporary sign on any lands or buildings or structures within the controlled area of a County Road without a permit.

2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date it is passed by County Council.

By-law read a first, second and third time and finally enacted this 23rd day of January, A.D., 2001.
